

SUMMARY OF THE MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY 18 JULY 2022

Treasurer's Report Key Points

- 98 members, compared with 83 during the same period in 2021.
- Total income was £2560 with an estimate of £3570 at 31 December 2022.
 Expenditure was £647 with an estimate of £4100 at 31 December 2022, giving a loss of £525.

Returning to the Cruck Barn

Members considered the practical aspects of returning to the Cruck Barn in September. A member 'Setting Up Group' would make the practical arrangements for the meetings. People would need to sign in for fire safety and there will be a door minder for each talk.
