SPRINGTIME SCIONWOOD SWAP AT 'GRAFT & GROW': BUCKINGHAM, MK18 4AE

- ❖ Date: Saturday 03-Feb-24, from 10.00am to 4:00pm (6 hours)
- ❖ Venue: Buckingham Garden Centre, Tingewick Road, Buckingham, MK18 4AE
- * Activities: Bring your scionwood to share and swap with others, or offer or acquire for a small donation. As always, this event will feature hundreds of rare, local and heritage apple, pear, plum and cherry varieties. They can be grafted on the day (as a paid service) onto purchased rootstocks of choice, or be taken home for grafting to make new fruit trees. This is a really great way to obtain and distribute rare and unusual varieties of fruit tree for gardens, home or community orchards, fields and hedgerows.

- Price: FREE entry! Scionwood may be swapped for free, or acquired/provided for a small donation per piece or bundle, at the supplier's discretion. Rootstocks are at their retail prices, discounted for five or more. There is also a charge for the grafting service per tree, with a discount for five trees or more.

TRAINING COURSE: WINTER PRUNING: ADDERBURY, OX17 3NA

- ❖ Date: Friday 23-Feb-24, from 10.30am to 4.00pm (including lunchtime)
- Venue: The Methodist Church Hall, on corner of High Street and Chapel Lane, Adderbury, OX17 3NA
- Activities: Join MSOG's Andy Howard for a day's training course, to learn the theory, skills and practice of Winter Pruning for fruit trees such as apple and pear. Discover the different methods and techniques used to shape fruit trees, control their size and influence their productivity. Find out when and how to apply these to suit different circumstances and different types of top fruit. Learn the difference between Winter and Summer Pruning and when and how to prune pip fruit like apples and pears and stone fruit like plums and cherries. Practice the theory on real fruit trees, to gain these skills yourself and gain the confidence to apply them in your own orchard, garden or community orchard.

TRAINING COURSE: GRAFTING: ADDERBURY, OX17 3NA

- Date: Saturday 24-Feb-24, from 10.30am to 4.00pm (including lunchtime)
- Venue: The Methodist Church Hall, on corner of High Street and Chapel Lane, Adderbury, OX17 3NA
- * Activities: Join MSOG's Andy Howard to learn the theory, skills and practice of grafting fruit trees such as apple and pear. Discover the history of grafting and its importance today. Find out how to select, collect and store "scion" wood and rootstocks for grafting, the different types of fruit tree that can be used and what can be grafted onto which type. Learn about the types of rootstocks available and how they affect the tree you produce; the methods used to graft fruit trees; why a graft fails or succeeds and the aftercare required for newly grafted trees. You will also get to create and take home your very own grafted fruit tree, using scionwood collected from heritage varieties and a choice of rootstocks.
